

**A Financial Update:** Our total revenue for the months of January and February was \$32,603.09 while the expenses were \$31,687.46. This left a surplus of \$915.63. However, these numbers do not show the true picture as over \$10,000 in the revenue was from the Presbyterian Ladies to pay for the church insurance. In reality, we are operating on a deficit basis each month. To cover our expenses, the givings for each Sunday should be an average of \$3,400 to \$3,500. We all should give prayerful thought on what each of us are able to do to help with the operation and function of our church. Have we as individuals reviewed what we give to the church? When was the last time we increased our givings? Every little bit helps - even if it is an extra dollar a week.
