Good morning and welcome to today's service. You are invited downstairs for a time of refreshment and fellowship following the service this morning.

Music in the Park continues at Riverside Park at 3 p.m. Don and Anne Aitchison will be performing.

There will be a Closing Service for the Holstein Church building next Sunday, September 28 at 2 p.m. It will be followed by a time of refreshments. You are all invited and encouraged to attend to support our church family members during this emotional time.

A new Bible Study program will begin this Wednesday, September 24 at 6 p.m. There will be three parts to the evening: first to listen to the BEMA poscast, followed by discussion and then fellowship. BEMA (or bimah) is a Hebrew word refering to the elevated platform in 1st century synaagogues where people read the Text.
